## About Stanmer

**Its history** The park has been shaped by human activity for 5000 years. In the 18th century the Pelham family bought and landscaped the park and built Stanmer House.

**Its buildings** Stanmer House is an impressive restored building and has a lounge bar. The church and pond opposite create a beautiful park setting. There are tea rooms and accessible public toilets in Stanmer Village. Please respect the privacy of the residents of the village.

**Its natural beauty** The park makes up part of a nationally important landscape, now designated as the South Downs National Park. The park woodland is particularly attractive in the spring when bluebells carpet the floor.



## Things to do

### Stanmer Park Easy Access Route

This five mile surfaced route is one of many walks and activities shown in the Stanmer & Ditchling Beacon 'Downs on your Doorstep' leaflet. For a copy phone 01273 292929 or go to [www.brighton-hove.gov.uk/countryside](http://www.brighton-hove.gov.uk/countryside).

You can Breeze up to Ditchling Beacon on the 79 bus, do a stunning 2.8 mile walk to Stanmer Park and return to Brighton on the 78 bus.

**Stanmer Rural Museum** is located near to Stanmer House, open most weekend afternoons.

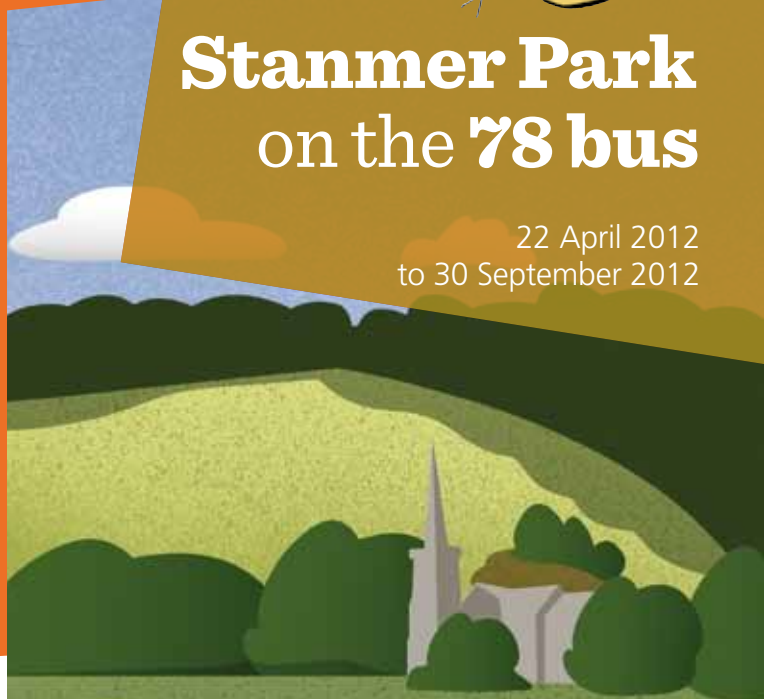

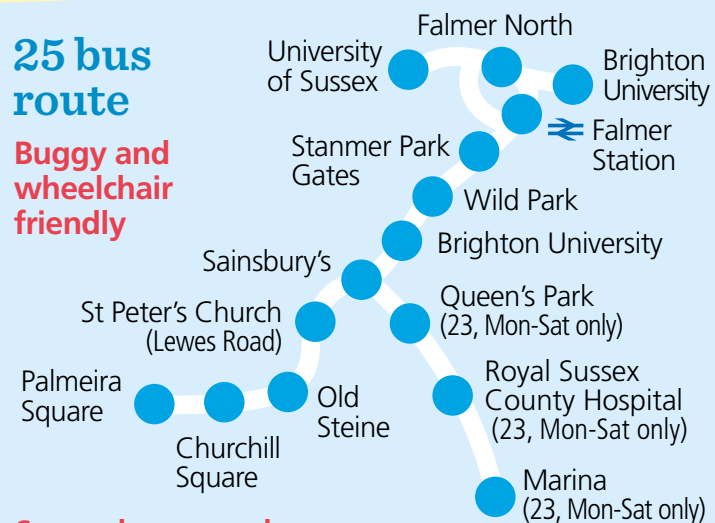

## 78 bus route

**Buggy Bus**  
Low-floor easy access bus: no need to fold pushchairs!



**Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays**

Within Stanmer Park, the 78 bus will stop anywhere on request. There is free travel for journeys only within the park. Service 78 is run by Brighton & Hove Bus Company. For bus info and any comments call 01273 292480 or visit [www.buses.co.uk](http://www.buses.co.uk). The 78 bus runs every 15 mins for Sussex Festival of Nature, 24 June.

## Fares

**Adults** £2.20 single, £4.40 for a City Saver.

Between Moulsecoomb (The Avenue) and Stanmer Village it is only £1.50 single (bus 78 only).

Free travel for anyone using the bus to travel only within the park itself.

**Children** Up to two children (under 16) go free when travelling with an adult on bus 78. BUS ID holders travel for 60p each way. Other children (5-13 only) pay half fare.

**National Bus Pass holders** travel free.

**SuperSaver tickets** are valid for unlimited travel on services 77, 78 and 79 – and on all services operated by Brighton & Hove Buses. If also going to Ditchling Beacon or Devil's Dyke you'll need to have a SuperSaver (£6.50 if buying it on the bus).

**Rail tickets** Show a rail ticket(s) valid to Brighton or Hove and get two 78 bus tickets for the price of one, or a third off an individual ticket (except Savers).

**Day 'Explorer' tickets** are issued and accepted.
