**Can they buy a **PLUSBUS** ?**

**PLUSBUS** can be purchased when buying a train ticket from anywhere in the UK to any rail station in the Brighton & Hove **PLUSBUS** area. These include Aldrington, Brighton, Falmer, Hove, Fishersgate, London Road, Moulsecomb, Portslade, Preston Park, Shoreham, and Southwick rail stations are also served, or are very close to our routes.

**Is **PLUSBUS** available online ?**

Unfortunately **PLUSBUS** is not yet available online, but if you do buy your train tickets online and take your ticket to the station ticket office they will be happy to add **PLUSBUS** to your ticket.

**That sounds great, but how do I know how to get to the station from where I live ?**

There are 20 **Brighton & Hove** services that serve Brighton Station alone from all over the city. Aldrington, Brighton, Falmer, Hove, Fishersgate, London Road, Moulsecomb, Portslade, Preston Park, Shoreham, and Southwick rail stations are also served, or are very close to our routes.

Just pick up a copy of **Bus Times**, or go online at [www.buses.co.uk](http://www.buses.co.uk) to see which rail station is the most convenient to you.

**Can I only use **PLUSBUS** when travelling to the train station ?**

No, you can use your **PLUSBUS** to travel anywhere within the Brighton **PLUSBUS** zone (see map) and at **ANYTIME** for however long your ticket is valid. That means if you add **PLUSBUS** to your annual train ticket you can travel on any **Brighton & Hove** buses at the weekend too.

### What is **PLUSBUS** ?

**PLUSBUS** is an integrated ticket which is a great way of combining train and bus travel around the Brighton & Hove area.

### What does **PLUSBUS** do ?

**PLUSBUS** allows the ticket holder to add unlimited bus travel in Brighton & Hove to their train ticket.

### I live in Brighton & Hove but travel out of the city every day, can I get **PLUSBUS** ?

Yes. **PLUSBUS** is available as an add-on to your season ticket for travel in Brighton & Hove and can be added for travel in Brighton & Hove on any advance purchase ticket.

### Where can I buy **PLUSBUS** ?

At any UK rail station or ticket agency, including our own **1 Stop Travel shops**. Just ask for **PLUSBUS** when buying your train ticket, and say whether you want bus travel at the start, the finish, or both ends of your journey.

### What time restrictions apply to my bus travel ?

None at all!

### How much will the **Brighton & Hove PLUSBUS** add on to the cost of my rail ticket ?

Less than you may think!

- **£2** for a day ticket..... Saving up to **£2.50\***
- **£1** for an under 16s day ticket..... Saving up to **£1.25\***
- **£9** for a 7 day ticket..... Saving up to **£7.00\*/£4.00\*\***
- **£30** for a 1 month ticket..... Saving up to **£23.00\***
- **£60** for a 3 month ticket..... Saving up to **£78.00\***
- **£200** for an annual ticket..... Saving you up to **£230.00\***
